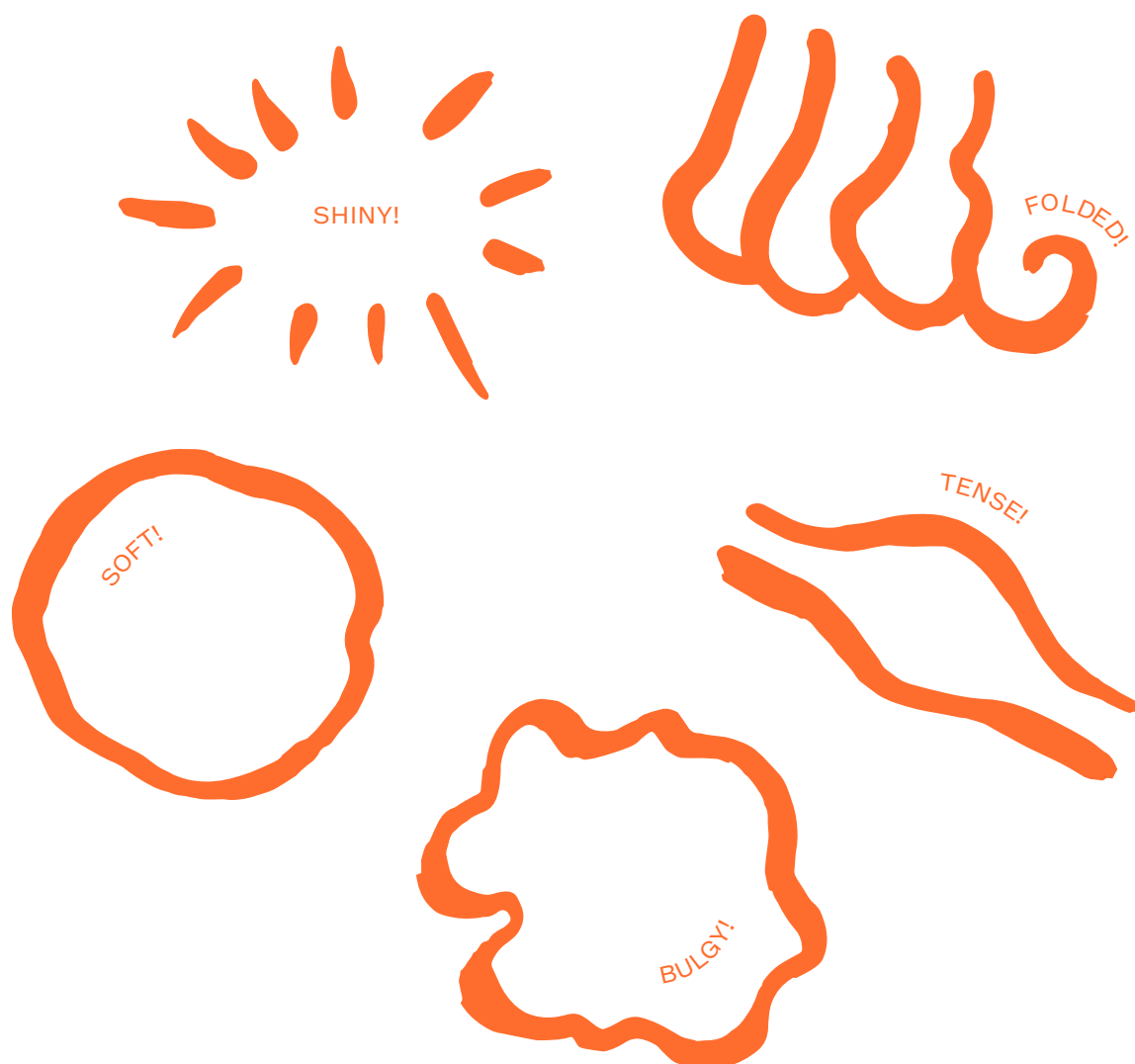


Five spots

This game is about looking closely at the sculptures and, optionally, comparing them to yourself. Use the five spots to start a conversation about the sculptures' bodies and your own.

How to play:

1. Pick a sculpture.
2. Talk about the spots where the sculptures and your own bodies are folded, bulgy, shiny, tense or soft. Remember not to touch the sculptures.



The game can be adapted depending on your mood and the age of the children. You can play "Find the shiniest spot", where you look for shiny spots on all the sculptures and find the shiniest one. You can also continue the game outside the Glyptotek and look for bulgy or shiny spots, etc. That also gives you something to do on the way home!
