A line on an artwork can never be completely erased. Only use pencils when writing and drawing, and put them away as soon as you're done.

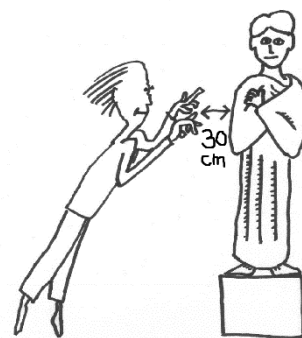
Writing implements are not allowed in the painting galleries and in special exhibitions. Teachers and adults are responsible for students using their pencils safely!

The pedestals can topple. Do not touch!

Walk together in a group. No more than 30 people in any one group.
